Being surrounded by likeminded individuals builds friendships and an improved social network. This creates a sense of belonging, assisting in a reduced sense of isolation.



- 1. All new students complete a phone conversation with our Support and Engagement Manager or senior support worker.*
- 2. Spots are finalised in August and students are advised of their Tutors location, and timing of their class. Remember your enrolment is for the full 10-week program.*
- 3. Your first day (Sep 14, 2023) is your welcome and orientation day.*

PROGRAM FEES


*For 2023 the 10-week program fees are **\$2,900** for the full course (includes non-refundable application fee of \$300).*

- Students who enroll and are accepted into the program are enrolled for the full 10-week program and are liable for the fees.*
- Actors Centre Australia is not an NDIS provider however we allow students to pay for the program using their NDIS.*
- Invoices are provided at five-week intervals requiring payment to continue the course. Payment options are available. Direct debit is available.*

3-10	Theatre scene rehearsal	Students will rehearse two hand theatre scenes, preparing for the week 11 live performance.
11	Live performance showcase	The live performance will consist of each student performing their live theatre scene in front of an invited audience.
