Dean has been Head of Acting at The Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts, Perth, Australia and The National Institute of Dramatic Arts, Sydney, Australia. Dean has also taught in 9 countries including New Zealand, the UK, the USA, Russia, France, Singapore, Indonesia, Brazil, and Vietnam as well as in most major acting schools across the world.

Dean has been working professionally since 1977 and now lives and works outside of Sydney in the Southern Highlands, Australia, where he continues to write, create curriculum, coach online and share his skills, creative commitment and engagement with the community.
